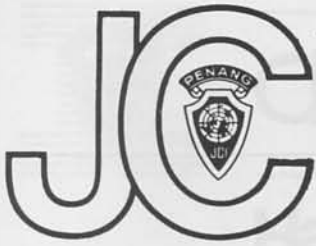
## Message

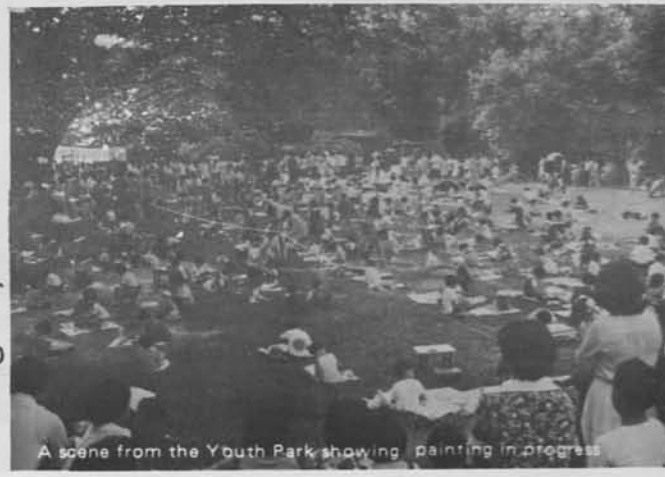
