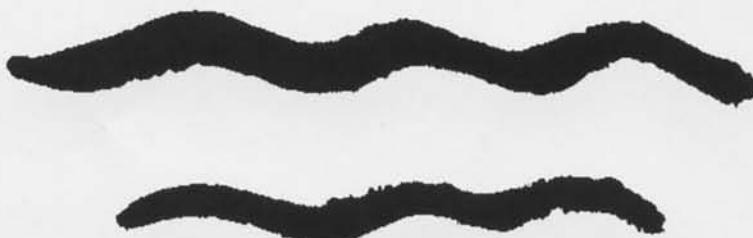

History of the Creed

The Jaycee is a sincere and beautiful gift of William Brownfield to all members of the Junior Chamber International.

Brownfield was inspired to write the six-tenet creed when he first became a Jaycee and attend the 1946 U.S. National Convention.

The creed sums up in so very few words, the ideals and purpose of an organization that believes in God and the dignity of the human being. It advances the values of free government and free enterprise. It places an infinite price on the uniqueness of man and the inherent good in him. And above all, the creed espouses the thought and encourages the practice that service to humanity is the best work in life.

The Jaycee Creed was officially adopted by the United States Jaycees in 1947, and later by the Junior Chamber International in 1951.



Current Facts

- NAME:** Jaycees International (JCI) is a worldwide association of young people between the ages of 18 and 40, which welcomes all nationalities, races and religions.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Close to 450,000 in nearly 12,000 communities throughout 75 member nations.
- PURPOSES:** The purposes of the Jaycees, as outlined in the JCI Constitution, are to "contribute to the advancement of the global community by providing the opportunity for young people to develop the leadership skills, social responsibility and fellowship necessary to create positive change."
- HISTORY:** The organization was founded in St. Louis, Missouri, U.S.A., by Henry Giessenbier on October 13, 1915. His idea spread and on December 11, 1944, representatives from eight nations met in Mexico City and the world organization — Jaycees International (JCI) — was founded.
- 1988 PRESIDENT:** Senator Jennifer Yu of Hong Kong
- HEADQUARTERS:** The Jaycees International (JCI) Secretariat is located in Coral Gables, Florida, U.S.A. A staff of 33 provides trilingual membership and development services to its Local and National Organization Members. Its chief administrative officer is the Secretary General, Dan Lamey.
- THEME:** Each year, Jaycees International adopts a major emphasis theme program which is implemented on a worldwide basis. The theme that is selected relates to a major problem or problems with universal significance. In this theme program members can select from a number of specific projects that are most relevant to the needs of their respective communities.
- The theme program adopted for 1988 is JAYCEES YOUNG PEOPLE FOR WORLD PEACE. It is somewhat unique for an organization like Jaycees International to become so involved in such an enormous issue, but, as a leadership training organization, it has the responsibility of directing this leadership and community initiative into a program that is based on the search for a better world balance and, ultimately, world peace.
- AREAS OF OPPORTUNITY:** This concept promotes the adoption, by national and local organizations, of a balanced program of activities which will offer the membership: individual, management, community and international opportunities.
- RIGHTS OF THE CHILD:** JCI recognizes and supports the United Nations Declaration of the Rights of the Child. In 1979, Jaycees throughout the world conducted programs which directly affected the lives of more than eleven million children. Since then, national and local Jaycee organizations conduct permanent and continuing programs to assist with providing for the basic needs of children as set out in the Declaration.
- OFFICIAL PUBLICATION:** LEADER, printed in English, French, Japanese, Spanish, Chinese and Korean, with a worldwide circulation of nearly 500,00.
- ANNUAL MEETING:** The 43rd JCI World Congress will be held in Sydney, from November 12-19, 1988.

Hong Kong Jaycees History

The Jaycee Movement reached Hong Kong in 1949, when a Philippine Jaycee John Ng who was the Special Liaison Officer of the JCI 15th Congress and was charged with the mission of converting Hong Kong to Jayceism arrived in November. Through the introduction of his cousin, Mr. Alex Ng, a Jaycee Senator still, Mr. John Ng was presented to Rev. E. Bourke, former director of Wah Yan College, Hong Kong. A meeting was then arranged for him to meet a group of young businessmen. During the meeting, Mr. John Ng's explanation of the aim and purpose of the Jaycee movement succeeded in firing the imagination of his audience. Eight days later, sponsor group of the Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was formed and Mr. Paul Lim was elected as Convenor of the organizing committee. Mr. Austin Coates from Hong Kong Government, then as Assistant Colonial Secretary of Hong Kong, was assigned to serve as Advisor to the Organizing Committee.

The tempo of laying the foundation of the Chamber was further stepped up when Mr. Ramon V Del Rosario, the JCI Vice-President for Asia, offered to recommend prompt recognition of the Hong Kong's Jaycee membership status. He also invited the Organizing Committee to send observers to Manila to attend the JCI 5th Congress. On 21st March, 1950, a sponsors meeting was called to receive the report of the return observers from Manila. The account of their vivid experience gave Hong Kong a deeper insight into Jaycee movement. A week later, the Provisional Constitution which had been in the making during the previous three months was adopted. Finally, on 6th April, 1950, the Inaugural General Meeting of the Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was held and the first Board of Directors was elected. One month thence, on 6th May, 1950, the Chamber was held and the first Board of Directors was elected. One month thence, on 6th May, 1950, the Chamber was inaugurated by Mr. Roberto Vianueva, the JCI Vice-President for Asia. Thus, The Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was born.

- 1950 — 1st JCI Regional for Asia was held in Hong Kong. The Governor of Hong Kong officiated the Opening Ceremony.
- 1952 — Mr. J.S. Lee was elected as Vice-President of Junior Chamber International for Asia.
- 1954 — 4th JCI Regional Conference for Asia was held in Hong Kong.
- 1956 — Mr. A. de O. Sales was elected as JCI World President, a great honour indeed to the Hong Kong Jaycees.
- 1957 — Mr. Francis J. Chan was elected as JCI Vice-President for Commissions.
- 1962 — The 17th World Congress of Junior Chamber International was hosted by Hong Kong Jaycees. (The surplus of the Congress was put into investment under the management of the Board of Trustees which should consist of the current President and four other person drawn from and elected by members of the 17th World Congress Organizing Committee and the past Presidents of the Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce.)
- 1965 — The Kowloon Junior Chamber was formed and the then existing members of Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce later called themselves Victoria Junior Chamber. Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce then became the National Organization consisting of two LOMs as mentioned above.
- 1966 — JCI Regional Conference was again held in Hong Kong.
 - Island Junior Chamber, the third Local Chapter, was established and affiliated to Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce.
 - Mr. Bahar Ramchandani was elected as JCI Vice-President for Operations.
- 1967 — "HARBOURLIGHTS," the official magazine of Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce, was given the "Best NOM Publication" award at the World Congress in Toronto, Canada.
- 1969 — Peninsula Junior Chamber, the first Chinese speaking chapter, was formed and affiliated to Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce.
 - Towards the end of the year, the Hong Kong Jayceettes, the first all-lady chapter, was formed and affiliated to Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce.
- 1971 — At the National Convention in October, the Lion Rock Junior Chamber, another Chinese speaking chapter, was affiliated with Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce, becoming the sixth local chapter in Hong Kong.
- 1972 — The Hong Kong Jaycees and Jayceettes hosted a JCI Regional Conference in April.
- 1974 — Proposed by Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce, an Asian Pacific Development Council was established at the Tai Chung Conference, Mr. Alex Tzang the then National President of Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce, was elected as Chairman of the Council.
- 1975 — The Hong Kong Jaycees celebrated its Silver Jubilee with His Excellency The Governor as Guest of Honour.
 - Mr. Alex Tzang was elected as JCI Vice-President and appointed as Chairman of the Jamaica JCI Regional Conference.
- 1976 — Senator Paul Yin was elected as APDC Councillor.
- 1977 — Senator Jennifer Yu was elected as APDC Councillor.
 - Two more Chinese speaking chapters, Harbour Jaycees and Yuen Long Jaycees were formed and affiliated to Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce.
 - Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce was awarded Jaycees International Presidential Award of Excellence for Outstanding Achievement in Chapter Extension with an increase of 25%.
 - The Hong Kong Jayceettes won "Assistance to Handicapped" Award at the Johannesburg World Congress.
- 1978 — Tai Ping Shan Jaycees, the 9th chapter in Hong Kong was formed and affiliated.
 - Jaycees International NOM Officer Training School hosted by harbour Jaycees was held in Hong Kong.
 - Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce won 3 awards and one certificate of merit during Manila Congress, topped by Most Outstanding New LOM Award — Harbour Jaycees.
- 1979 — Mr. Peter Tsang was elected as JCI Vice-President.
 - Senator Major Tang was elected as APDC Councillor.
 - 1979 JCI Hong Kong Conference hosted by Hong Kong Jayceettes was successfully held in Hong Kong with over 1,700 delegates attending.
 - Bauhinia Jaycees, the first all-day Chinese speaking chapter, sponsored by Peninsula Jaycees was approved as a provisional chapter.
 - Dragon Jaycees, an English speaking chapter, was approved as a provisional chapter.
 - Hong Kong Junior Chamber was awarded Jaycees International President Award of Excellence for Outstanding Achievement in Growth with an increase of over 50% in membership.
- 1980 — The Hong Kong Jaycees its 30th Anniversary.
 - Mr. John Lo was elected as JCI Vice-President.
 - Bauhinia Jaycees was affiliated as the 10th Chapter.

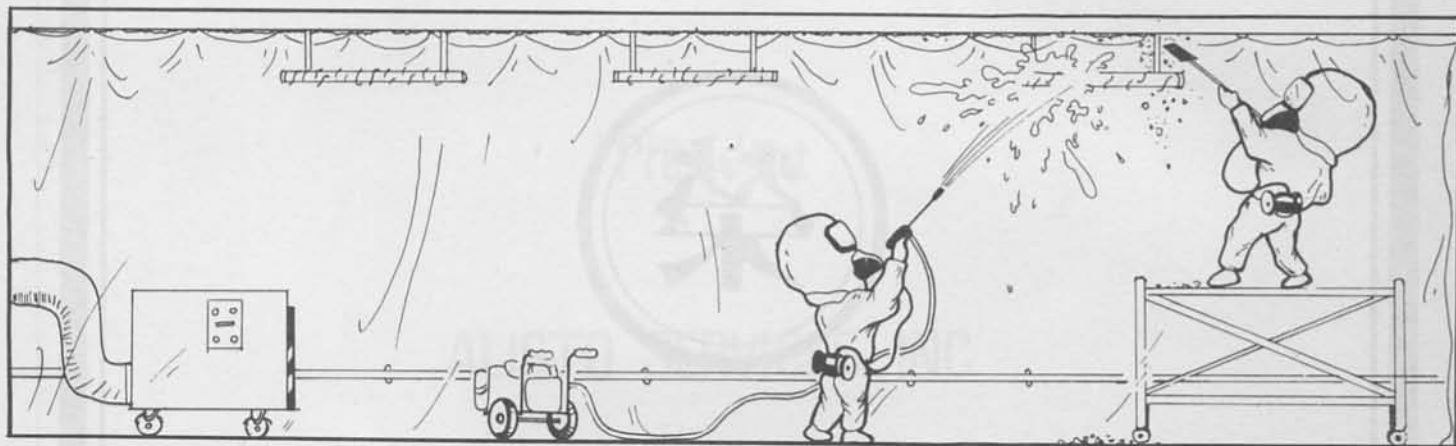

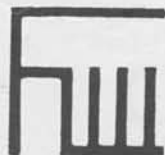

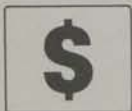
