

**The 58th National Convention
Nomination Committee Report
22nd – 24th September 2023**

1. Nomination for 2024 National Officers

As of the closing of the nomination on 7th August, 2023, the following nomination forms for 2024 Elective National Officers have been received:

An announcement on the candidates for the 2024 National Officers was made to the LOMs on 10th August 2023.

Subsequently on 15th September 2023, the Nomination Committee received a letter from JCI East Kowloon, mentioning that its member YIU, Ka Chi will withdraw from the election as a NVP candidate due to personal reason.

2. Nomination Committee

The Nomination Committee has been appointed by National President Senator Kenneth YU to assess the qualification and eligibility of the candidates and present a report to General Assembly of 58th National Convention. Apart from me serving as the Chairman, the Nomination Committee includes five other members:

1996 National President Senator Justin LUI
2006 National President Senator James TSUI
2010 National President Senator Gene TANG
2017 National President Senator Teresa POON
2019 National President Senator Zenith LIN

3. Eligibility and Qualification of Candidates

The procedure for the election of 2024 Elective National Officers is conducted in accordance with the Articles of Association and By-laws of Junior Chamber International Hong Kong. All candidates are required to observe and comply with these clauses therein.

The qualifications for candidates of the Elective & Appointed National Officers are contained in JCIHK By-law 12-4. Specific Requirements for NP, NEVPs, NVPs, NGLC, NSG, NHT and NDs are contained in By-laws 12-9-3, 12-11-2, 12-12-2, 12-10-2, 12-13-2, 12-14-2 and 12-15-2 respectively.

Given the withdrawal of YIU, Ka Chi (JCI East Kowloon) as a NVP candidate, the assessment of his eligibility and qualification is not included in this Nomination Committee Report. However, he attended the candidate interview as mentioned in point 5 below. We considered it appropriate to keep his interview result in appendix 1, as an official record of his effort made for the election process.

The Nomination Committee confirms that one candidate cannot fulfil the qualifications as specified in By-law 12-4, and some of the candidates are not eligible for the offices they are standing for election and appointment, as entailed below.

The following Candidate fails to meet a specific requirement under By-law 12-4-5, i.e. Candidates for elective members of the National Board of Directors shall attend Candidates Training School organized by JCIHK within fifteen (15) days before the closing session of the Annual General Meeting of the National Convention at which they stand for election.

- National Executive Vice President Candidate
 - LEUNG, Sing Piu (JCI Kowloon)

The following Candidates fail to meet a specific requirement under By-law 12-12-2 (C), i.e. the candidate shall be a current member of the National Board of Directors or shall have been a member of the National Board of Directors for at least one year.

- National Vice President Candidates:
 - CHOI, Rex Chung Cheung (JCI Ocean)
 - HO, Tsz Yan (JCI Tai Ping Shan)
 - MANG, Chi Ho Lawrence (JCI Lion Rock)
 - SZE, Chin Ho (JCI Peninsula)
- National Honorary Treasurer Candidate:
 - SIU, King Him (JCI Island)

The Following National Director Candidates fail to meet specific requirement under By-law 12-15-2 (A), i.e. Candidates for National Director shall have been an Individual Member of JCIHK for at least two (2) years immediately before appointment:

- National Director Candidates:
 - LI, Chun Yu Bosco (JCI Dragon)
 - YEUNG, Man Yin (JCI Tsuen Wan)

Notwithstanding their failure to meet the specific requirements or qualifications, the above nine candidates may seek for election or appointment by way of a waiver in accordance with By-law 12-4-9. The Nomination Committee recommends such waiver be granted subject to the approval of the General Assembly by a two-third (2/3 majority) of the votes.

4. Candidates Training School

In accordance with By-law 12-4-5, all elective candidates except NEVPC LEUNG, Sing Piu (JCI Kowloon) attended the Candidate Training School with the following details:

5. Interview by the Nomination Committee

Interview for all candidates for Elective National Officers, as per Constitutional requirement (By-law 12-4-7), was conducted on 9th September, 2023, at the Chamber Office with the Nomination Committee assessing the ability of each candidate in the following areas:

- i. Junior Chamber Affairs at Local, National & International levels
- ii. Parliamentary Procedure
- iii. Articles of Association and By-laws of JCIHK
- iv. Duties of the respective offices and Problem Solving
- v. Community Affairs

The performance of individual candidate was graded in accordance with the following scale:

- i. Excellent
- ii. Very Good
- iii. Good
- iv. Fair
- v. Poor
- vi. Unsatisfactory

Interview results of each candidate in respective area are shown in Appendix 1 which was also posted on JCI Hong Kong website on or before 24th September, 2023.

According to the observation of the Nomination Committee, the candidates were confident and passionate. Most of them were well-prepared and generally have in-depth understanding on the Articles of Association and By-laws as well as their roles and responsibilities and JCI affairs, but they should be more aware of community and current affairs in order to be an informed leader and enhance their knowledge on parliamentary procedures as a role-model for LOMs.



In the post-pandemic era, management teams in the globe face even more challenges for picking up the pace and standard, and at the same time to create new trends. So the candidates are recommended to keep on learning and have high degree of agility and flexibility. Problem solving skill is definitely one of the important skills to lead under fast-changing world.

The Nomination Committee is looking forward to seeing a competent and capable team to serve JCI Hong Kong in 2024.

6. Closure of Nomination

In accordance with By-law 12-6-3, all nominations had been closed forty five (45) days prior to the commencement of the National Convention.
